TIPS FOR LOCATING PREVIOUS IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

Ask your parents or early care givers if they have a record of your childhood immunizations.

Look through any old papers saved from your childhood, such as a baby book for a written immunization record.

Ask your high school, previous colleges or employers (including the military) for immunization records.

Ask your health care provider or local health department to check their records and the MCIR (Michigan Care Improvement Registry) for immunization records. The MCIR is a State of Michigan centralized immunization registry that keeps electronic records of vaccines.

Understand that it is not always possible to locate written documentation of immunizations. When you can't document having received a required vaccine in the past, you may be re-vaccinated. For a few of the diseases, you may have blood tests to determine whether you are immune.
